
Why is Character Important?

- Building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost. Jude 1:20



FAITHFULNESS


Dependable, loyal, and full of trust.

Behaving well.




The Work of the Holy Spirit in you

Isaiah 61:1-3

- » The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;
- » To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;
- » To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified

John 14:16,26

- » 16: And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
- » 26: But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you

Ephesians 6:10,3:16

- » 6,10: Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.
- » 3,16: That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

2 Peter 1 5:9

- » And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;
- » And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;
- » And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
- » For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- » But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins

Galatians 2:20

» I am crucified with Christ:nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me:and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Ephesians 4:17-24

- » This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,
- » Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:
- » Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.
- » But ye have not so learned Christ;
- » If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:
- » That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
- » And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
- » And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
 Go back...

Romans 12:1-2

- » I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
- » And be not conformed to this world:but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Psalm 119:9-11, 105

- » 9: Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.
- » 10: With my whole heart have I sought thee:
 O let me not wander from thy commandments.
- » 11: Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.
- » 105: Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

Galatians 5:19-21

» Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like:of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God

Go back...

Galatians 5:22-26

- » But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance:against such there is no law.
- » And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.
- » If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.
- » Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.
