

The purpose of spiritual gifts

Cautions about spiritual gifts

- 1. Don't confuse gifts with natural talents.
- 2. Don't confuse gifts with the <u>fruit</u> of the spirit. Gal: 5:22-23
 - o "Fruit" shows my maturity.
 - o "Gifts" show my <u>ministry</u>.
- 3. Don't confuse gifts with Christian roles.
- 4. Be aware of the "gift-projection" tendency.

- Glorify God in His church: 1 Peter 4:10-11
- Build up the body of Christ: Eph 4:12
- Promote unity of the body: Eph 4:13
- Develop maturity of the body: Eph 4:14
- Promote growth of the body: Eph 4:16
- Promote the common good for all: 1 Cor 12:7
- Moving in our spiritual gifts requires a DEDICATION to service, stirred by love, in order to meet each other's needs or provide solutions joyfully

- Using my gift will cause me and the church to grow Ephesians 4:16
